ABOUT US

The Saskatoon Theological Union Library consortium consists of 4 library collections, housed in 2 locations:

- Saskatoon Theological Union Library houses the library collections of the College of Emmanuel & St. Chad, the Lutheran Theological Seminary, and St. Andrew's College.
- Horizon College & Seminary Library (A.C. Schindel Library) houses the library collection of Horizon College & Seminary

The STU Libraries' print collection consists of over 100,000 monographs and approximately 80 current journal subscriptions.

Our collections include resources on: preaching and pastoral care, theology, church history, biblical studies, social justice, and denomination specific materials. We are committed to developing Indigenous collections and resources.

Book sale items are available at both locations.

BORROWING, LOAN PERIODS, AND FINES

Our libraries are open to the public and anybody can become a patron, free of charge.

Most collection materials may be borrowed for three weeks.

Five renewals are available unless another user has requested the item. We do not charge late fines.

An extended loan may be available on request. You may borrow up to 100 books. Borrowed materials may be returned to either the STU Library or the Horizon College & Seminary Library, regardless of which library items were borrowed from. All materials are subject to recall.

All patrons and students at Horizon College & Seminary, the Lutheran Theological Seminary, College of Emmanuel & St. Chad, and St. Andrew's College have access to materials at both library locations. You can request to pick up materials at either of the locations.
